

Introduction

Esiqiwini High School is situated in Gunjaneni area under ward 14 in Umtubatuba. This school is surrounded by a community that is highly struck by poverty because of the high rate of unemployment in the country. This report will elaborate on the activities that were implemented by the Coach from the month of August 2024 to March 2025. The Star for Life activities have received a lot of support from the schools hence all planned activities were a successfully executed. Grade 8 to 10 wrote internal marked examinations papers while grade 11 and 12 wrote external examinations. Grade 12 examination is also marked externally.

Classroom sessions

The Coach started delivering Classroom
Sessions soon after the Learner Workshops
execution. In 2024 the Coach had implemented
most of the classroom sessions before the
month of August. The few sessions that were
delivered during this period were Grade 10
classroom sessions on: Assertive Communication, Sexual & Reproductive Health Rights,
Decision-Making and Transactional Relationships. These sessions were conducted
in classrooms setup with an aim of giving

learners free platform to engage in a topic delivered and gain more knowledge and clarity through questioning, role plays and presentation. During these sessions the Coach starts by recapping on their last session to figure if they still remember what was discussed and to also remind them what they have forgotten. The sessions were energetic through deploying energizers to keep them focus. The Coach reached 158 learners in through 8 classroom sessions conducted.



One-on-one Consultations

Individual one-on-one consultations are conducted by the Coach with learners who are facing different challenging situations. They are conducted in a private room which is usually one of the educator's offices for privacy and confidentiality. Some cases are referred by educators, induced by the Coach and sometimes some learners come to the Coach themselves. Most of the cases were domestic issues, career guidance, and dating affairs. The total number of 41 individual consultations were reached between the month of August 2024 to March 2025.

Daughters of Africa (DoA)

The Coach recruited 30 girls from grade 8 between the age of 13 to 15 years to form

a girls' club. The objective of this program is to give young girls knowledge about Gender Equality, Sexual & Reproductive Health Rights and Entrepreneurships. The aim of DoA is to empower young women to be independent, know they rights and be able to tell when they are treated unfairly because of their gender. With the 2024 DOA club we had a successful Market Day and girls were able to sell all their products on the day and they made good profits. This club enrol girls in 13 sessions. Other special activities during the period.

Star for Life Norway visited the school in January and donated sporting equipment which included soccer and basketball jerseys, soccer balls, basketball poles and many more. A big thank. It's always needed.

An example of individual consultation

A grade 8 girl and a boy (14 years) were found kissing behind the school water tank during class time. These learners were referred to the Coach as their affair actually interferred with their schoolwork and impacting negatively on their academic performance. The Coach engaged each learner through one-on one consultation, spoke about dreams and the importance of education, highlighting to each learner what things can delay or destroy one's dreams. They were educated about relationship and delaying sexual activities. The Coach conducted Classroom Sessions on dating affairs and consequences of engaging in intimate relationships as teenagers as these two were not the only learners in this grade who were in this kind of relationship.

Some challenges

Esiqiwini High School is a rural, under-re-sourced school. The school has several learners who have an interest in taking careers in the science field, but they are disadvantaged because the school does not have laboratories and computers to equip the leaners with basic computer skills and knowledge about science experiments. They don't have enough class-rooms and currently some learners are using park home as classrooms; however, those park homes are full in a way that it's difficult to move around the desks.
